Side Tilt Carriages

Rated by the blade carriage lifting capability, there are four sizes of hook type blade carriages. The hook type tine carriages have been standardized.

The carriage bar spacing used for Class 1 is about 13 inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to carry loads as much as 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to carry cargo up to 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type tines can be different depending on the manufacturer. Pin mounted forks could differ by the amount of offset between the tine eye and the blade. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
